Every applicant is sent detailed information about the date and time of the admission exams and the technical information in an electronic format.

THE ADMISSION PROCESS

1. PORTFOLIO

To have an understanding of the applicant's film making activities, to assess their creative skills based on the submitted materials.

Compulsory appendices:

The following 8 compulsory appendices have to be uploaded on a server specified later.

1. A short film, 2- max 3 minute-long film introducing the applicant. (Please send the film via a YouTube or Vimeo link (protected by a password).
2. Maximum 2-3 minutes long parts of already finished exam- and degree films or more important pieces of cameraman work - **it refers to only those applicants who graduated in Cameraman or cinematographer BA in 2021 or earlier.**
3. Photos taken by the applicant, maximum **10 pc**, in a pdf format
4. CV - including the professional activities (maximum 1 page)
5. Covering letter (maximum 1 page)
6. 3 film ideas on your choice, these form the basis of the film made in the admission procedure. **This refers to those applicants who have not participated in Cameraman or cinematographer BA training.**

7. A document proving that you have paid the admission fee.
(Please do not pay the admission procedure fee before you have received your information email containing your individual personal code provided by METU. Thank you for your patience.)
8. A statement of submitting only own, independent pieces of art. The statement can be downloaded here.

Those applicants who have graduated in Cameraman or cinematographer BA in 2021 or earlier do not have to make an introductory short film or to upload a film idea, only appendix 2, 3, 4, 5, 7, 8 and 9 refer to them.

2. PRACTICAL TASKS, INTERVIEW

The assignment is set in an e-mail

On the day of the admission exam a notification will be sent to you in an email about the **practical tasks**.

a) Every applicant will be notified about the title of the **film** on **a link** that is recommended to be watched by the Board. You have to write a typed essay about it, minimum one page, maximum two pages long, A4 size, Times New Roman fonts, font size: 12. The length of the film can be between 5 and 15 minutes. After you have watched the film, you have 60 minutes to write the essay and upload it to the drive.

b) Every applicant is invited to participate in the oral interview or topic discussion, via **Zoom**. Applicants are put in groups of 5. We will assign that ninety-minute long period in which the applicants have to be available. The Admission Board will have an interview with each applicant separately.

Those applicants who have not graduated in Cameraman or cinematographer BA the Board discusses the three optional film ideas for the admission procedure and the appendices uploaded in the first round.

Those applicants who have graduated in Cameraman or cinematographer BA or will graduate in 2021, do not have to shoot a film for the admission procedure, in

their case the Admission Board will accept the film analysis, the uploaded photos, parts from the previously made films or the degree film as the admission exam materials.

For this part of the exam you will need stable internet connection, as well as a device equipped with a camera, speakers and a microphone that can be used for a video conference.

A further condition of participating in the admission procedure is that in case the applicant holds a degree issued abroad, the applicant's request has been granted and your qualification stated in the submitted documents, school report or degree (certificate) has been accepted.

In case of accepting a degree (certificate) issued abroad for participating in higher education in Hungary, METU takes the decisions of the Hungarian Equivalence and Information Centre into consideration.

Budapest Metropolitan University takes a decision about accepting a degree (certificate) issued abroad for participating in higher education in Hungary and it is sent in a registered mail to the applicant.
